CONFIDENTIALITY

NEW PATIENTS

All new patients registering with the Practice will be requested to complete a medical questionnaire and registration form.

An appointment will then be made with the Nurse for a "New Patient Registration" examination. This enables the Nurse to carry out full health screening i.e. BP, weight, height, past and present medical history, and family history.

All patients will be allocated a named GP who will be responsible for your overall care at the Practice. You will be informed of your allocated GP following your registration. You may, however, choose to see whichever health care professional when requesting an appointment. If you have a specific GP you wish to be allocated to, please let us know and we will make every effort to accommodate this, however, we cannot guarantee this request.

ZERO TOLERANCE

The Practice has a Zero Tolerance Policy. This means the Practice will not tolerate any violence or aggression towards our staff. ABOUT THE PRACTICE

Denmark Street Surgery is situated on the corner of North Road and Denmark Street. We encourage patients to use our car parking facilities to avoid congestion in Denmark Street. Wheelchair access is available to most areas of the surgery. Our Nursing team work from the annex building within the surgery, we have an online checking in system for all appointments, simply scan the QR code which is located at the entrance of the surgery, confirm your date of birth and appointment time and check in is complete! Alternatively you are welcome to check in at the main reception desk.

We have a proud tradition of providing GP training for doctors as part of the Durham Tees Valley training scheme. These doctors are fully qualified and furthering their specialist training in General Practice. Each trainee works under the direct supervision of a GP trainer who is a senior doctor at the practice and their work is closely monitored. As part of their training, we may ask permission to record telephone or face to face consultations. We may also send out questionnaires asking you to rate how they perform. This is invaluable for the trainees and helps them become excellent GP's. Many of our current senior GP's started their careers training at the practice.

We also welcome nursing students from Teesside University to get some experience in General Practice and provide mentoring for nurses and other healthcare professionals who are completing their prescribing training.

SURGERY APPOINTMENT TIMES

Doctor and Nurse Practitioner telephone appointments are available Monday - Friday From 8am - 6pm. You can pre book a telephone appointment up to 1 week in advance subject to availability. Limited Doctor and Nurse Practitioner telephone appointments are available to book online.

Please be assured if a **face to face appointment** is required our Patient Liaison Team will contact you to book a convenient time for you.

If you require an **urgent** appointment please call the surgery at 8am.

For patient that are **too ill to attend the surgery** please call between 8am –10am to book a home visit. Where possible we would prefer you to attend the surgery as our Doctors have better facilities in the surgery to treat you.

Practice Nurse and Health Care Assistant appointments are available between 7.30am—17.30. Which consist of both face to face appointments and remote telephone reviews, our Patient Liaison Team will book you in appropriately.

Midwife –The Midwives attend the surgery every Wednesday and Thursday. Appointments can be made for routine antenatal checks at the surgery.

Out of hours appointments - Primary Healthcare Darlington provide evening and weekend GP, Nurse and Health Care Assistant appointments on behalf of all GP surgeries within Darlington, offering a truly 7 day service which is Located at Forsyth House.

Interpreter Services - Please let our Patient Liaison Team if you require an interpreter for your appointment.

E-consults - is an online service through our practice website or the NHS App to receive advice from a clinician within 48 hours.
